COMMUNITY NOTICE

The City is improving the **Junipero Serra Boulevard and King Drive intersection** to increase traffic safety for vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians starting now through November.

Improvements include:

- Redesigned medians and right-turn islands,
- New, more visible, overarching traffic signals,
- Protected left-turn phasing for King Drive,
- Speed feedback signs on Junipero Serra Boulevard,
- New bike lane markings through the intersection, and
- New ADA accessible curb ramps and crosswalks.

The first two months of construction will impact traffic as the City contractor reconstructs the eight median islands to create a wheelchair accessible path around all four areas of the intersection.

During active construction, the construction zone speed limit on Junipero Serra Boulevard **will be reduced to 35 mph for safety**. After the median construction is complete, traffic impacts will be minor and intermittent as the contractor installs new traffic signals and other equipment.
